Prof. dr. Bart P.M. Joosen, LLM (1963) is professor of Financial Supervision Law at the VU University Amsterdam. He is also fellow of the European Banking Institute, Frankfurt, Germany. He has expertise on financial services supervision with a focus on micro-prudential supervision of banks, insurance companies, investment firms and payment services providers (including in-depth Basel I-IV and Solvency II knowledge). He has published widely in these areas in national and international law journals and is author of a number of Dutch language books on these topics. Together with Profs. Marco Lamandini and Tobias Tröger he is editor of and author of a number of Chapters in 'Capital and Liquidity Requirements for European Banks' in the Oxford EU Financial Regulation Series, Oxford University Press (December 2021).
